

MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The Members of the Association are divided into regular and honorary. The status of regular member is obtained after approval of the Board of Directors which decides on the application of the interested party, at the latest within one month of its submission.

Only regular members have the right to elect and be elected, as long as they have fulfilled their obligations to the Association. Late subscription payments can also be made on election day before voting.

Regular Members

Any person residing in Greece or abroad (over the age of 18) or legal entity from the private and the public, can become a regular member, provided that they submit a signed application to the Board of Directors and pay the registration fees and the annual subscription, which is defined by the Board of Directors of the Association. The Board of Directors decides on its acceptance or not at its first meeting after the submission of the application.

Honorary Members

By unanimous decision of the Board of Directors, the title of honorary member may be awarded to persons who have developed exceptional activity for purposes similar to those of the Association or who have provided excellent services to it.

Any legal entity from the private or the public sector can also become Honorary Members.

Member Obligations

1. Regular members are required to pay an annual contribution to the Association of a minimum amount of thirty (30) Euros. The above amounts may be changed annually by decision of the Board of Directors, but may not be lower than those mentioned above. Failure to pay a membership fee for three years entails its deletion, by decision of the Board of Directors, after a written notification of the treasurer and a deadline of 15 days from the receipt of the letter. However, in this case, the possibility of re-registration is provided. Honorary members are exempt from the obligation of financial assistance to the Association.
2. All members of the Association are obliged to contribute to the realization of its purposes and to respect and abide by the decisions of its administrative bodies and to comply with the legislation concerning Unions and with the provisions of the statute.

Member Rights

1. All regular members of the Association have the right to receive information on any matter concerning the Association, to participate in General Assemblies, in elections, provided they have fulfilled their financial obligations to the Association, to the Administration and other bodies of the Association, as well as to all kinds of its activities.
2. Honorary members enjoy all the rights of members, except to vote, to elect and to be elected, but they may attend general meetings with the right to speak.

Resignation of Members

1. The members of the Association have the right to leave by submitting a written resignation addressed to the Board of Directors. The withdrawal must be notified at least three months before its expiry and is valid until its end. Subsequently, the Board proceeds to delete him from the register of members.
2. Resigned members may re-register, as long as they follow the procedure provided for in the statute for new members and pay their subscriptions from the year of resignation until their re-registration.

Members Deletion

1. By decision of the Board of Directors, a member is removed from the Association for each of the following reasons:
 - a. Death.
 - b. Legal incapacity.
 - c. Serious reason, including proven activity that goes against the purposes of the Association, offends or defames it.
2. By decision of the General Assembly, regular or extraordinary, a member Association that develops activities contrary to its purposes or for a serious violation of the statutes is deleted from the Association.
3. A member who has been deleted from the Association may be re-registered by decision of the Board of Directors, provided that the reasons for his deletion have disappeared.
